



In 1969, the first vines were planted and a winery established in this area, which was traditionally sheep grazing pastures. As such, the locals considered it would only ever be one of a kind and thus the road leading to it was named "Winery Road". Despite their doubts, the area has flourished and is now recognized as an official Wine Region.

## VINTAGE 2013

Ideal Mediterranean winter and summer conditions resulted in a well balanced vintage.

Above average winter rainfall compensated for a very dry spring and summer, thus enabling the vine canopies to be well balanced by the time veraison occurred in mid December. The weather conditions at flowering were ideal, allowing good fruit set and no disease pressure.

Warmer than average December through to February temperatures brought harvest forward by 10 days than the customary start date, which commenced with whites the week beginning February 18<sup>th</sup>.

The March and April temperatures continued above average with unusually high night time temperatures. No significant summer rainfall was experienced.
